
GENERAL INFORMATION

Malta is centrally located in the middle of the Mediterranean Sea, just south of Sicily. The Maltese archipelago consists of three islands: Malta, Gozo & Comino. Their total population is approximately 400,000. The largest island of the group is Malta from which the archipelago takes its name & which accounts for just over 90.5% of the population. Valletta, the capital, is the cultural, administrative & commercial centre of the archipelago.

Malta is well served with harbours, the main international ports being the Valletta Grand Harbour & the Port of Marsaxlokk. The second largest island is Gozo which can be reached from Malta by ferry from the ports of Cirkewwa & Marsamxett or by seaplane from the port of Valletta. Gozo has one port – Mgarr.

Maritime activity centres around the two main Malta ports, Valletta and Marsaxlokk, although a number of other ports occasionally host ships on international voyages, usually passenger vessels. Both are capable of providing a comprehensive package of maritime services including towage, salvage, pilotage, victualling and provisions of all kinds of stores and supplies.

APPROACH INFORMATION

Any watercraft going through any of the ports must communicate ETA to the Valletta or Marsax-lokk Port Control prior to arrival or departure. ETA contents should include Name of Water craft, Port of Registration, IMO or Official Number, Length Overall, Draft, Beam, Agent, Nature of Cargo, Number of Passengers, Last Port of Call and permission to enter or leave port

VHF calls include Channels 12/14/16. – 24/7 Service Ship / Yacht agent services, Port formalities, Pilotage and Mooring services are compulsory for watercrafts exceeding 300 GT.
