

GENERAL INFORMATION

The Island of Tenerife is the largest of the Canaries Islands, located approx 300 km off the North African coast. The island is approx 2034 km² in area and has a population of around 890,000, which is around 43% of Canaries' total population. The port is located less than a kilometre from the capital, Santa Cruz, on the northeast coast of the island.

Santa Cruz de Tenerife is Canary Islands' largest cruise port and is used for fishing, commercial, sports and passengers. As a cruise port, Tenerife is ranked as Spain's 2nd busiest - after Barcelona, handling nearly 1 million cruise ship passengers a year. Tenerife concentrates a large movement of goods, with shipping lines operating to connect the island to the island of Gran Canaria, but also to important Spanish ports, such as Barcelona and Cadiz. It is managed by the Port Authority of Santa Cruz de Tenerife, which includes all commercial and leisure ports of the Province of Santa Cruz de Tenerife; El Hierro, La Gomera, La Palma and Tenerife islands.
